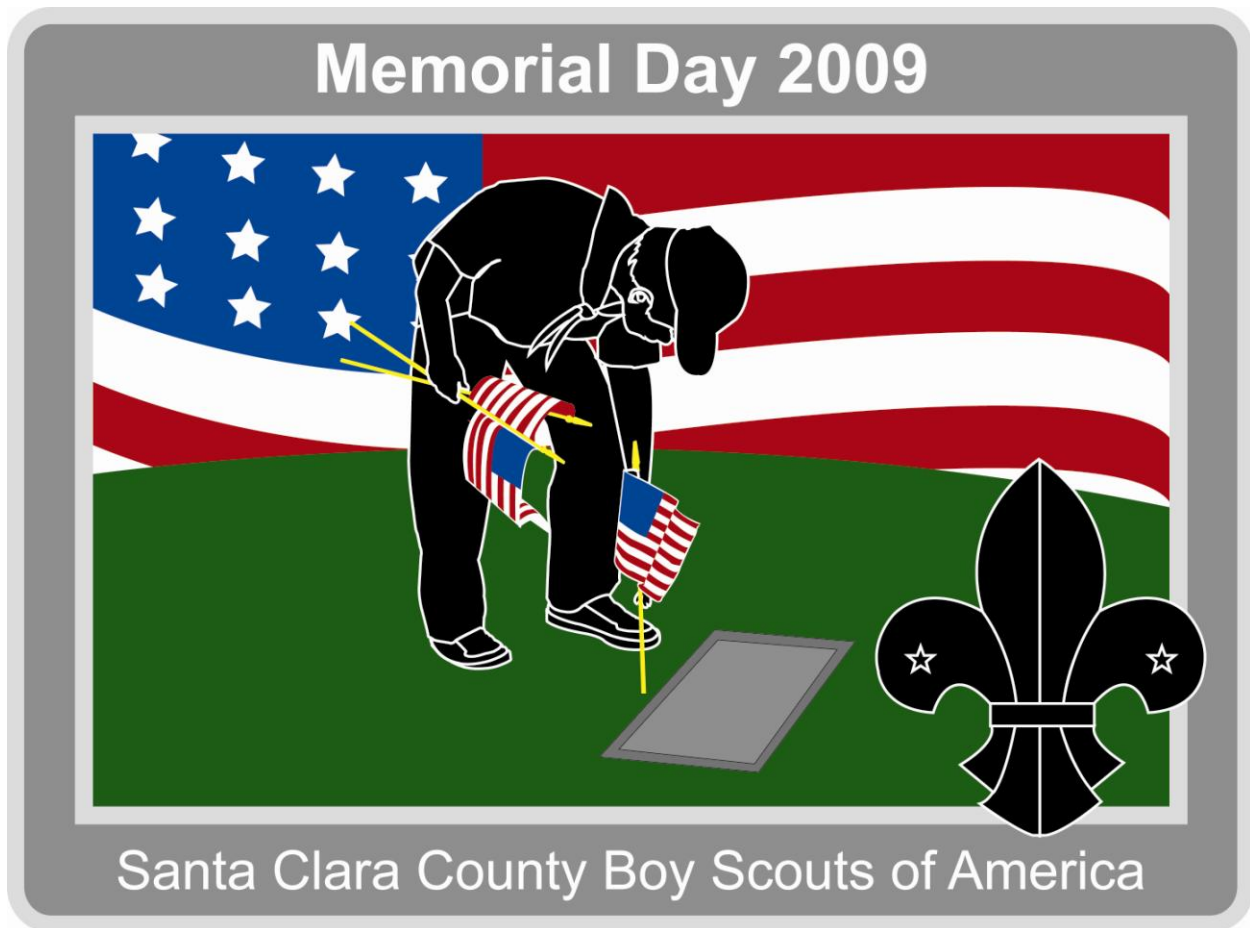

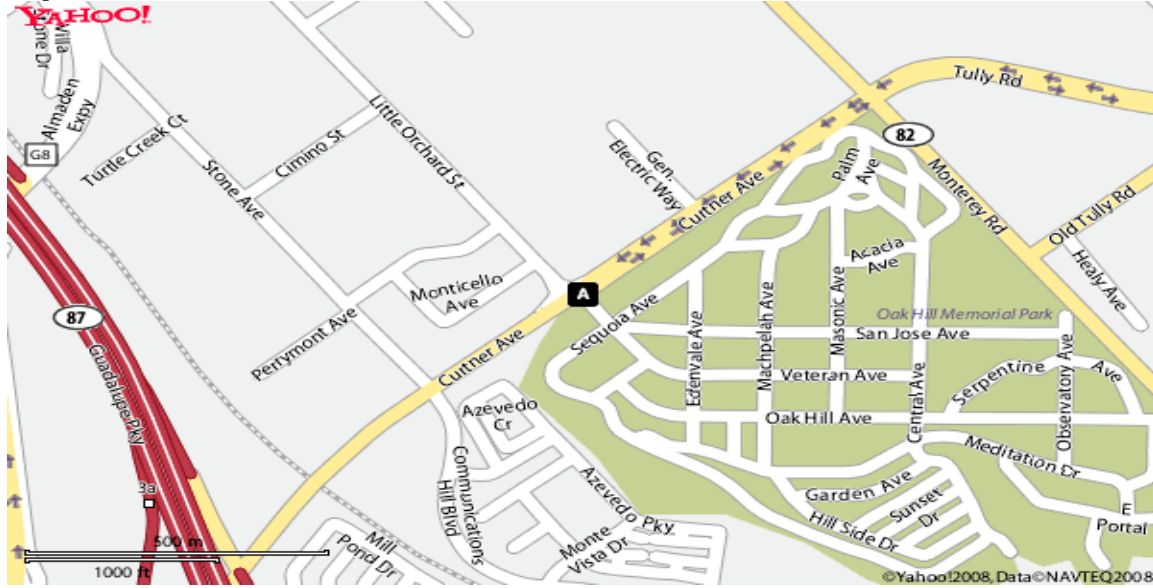

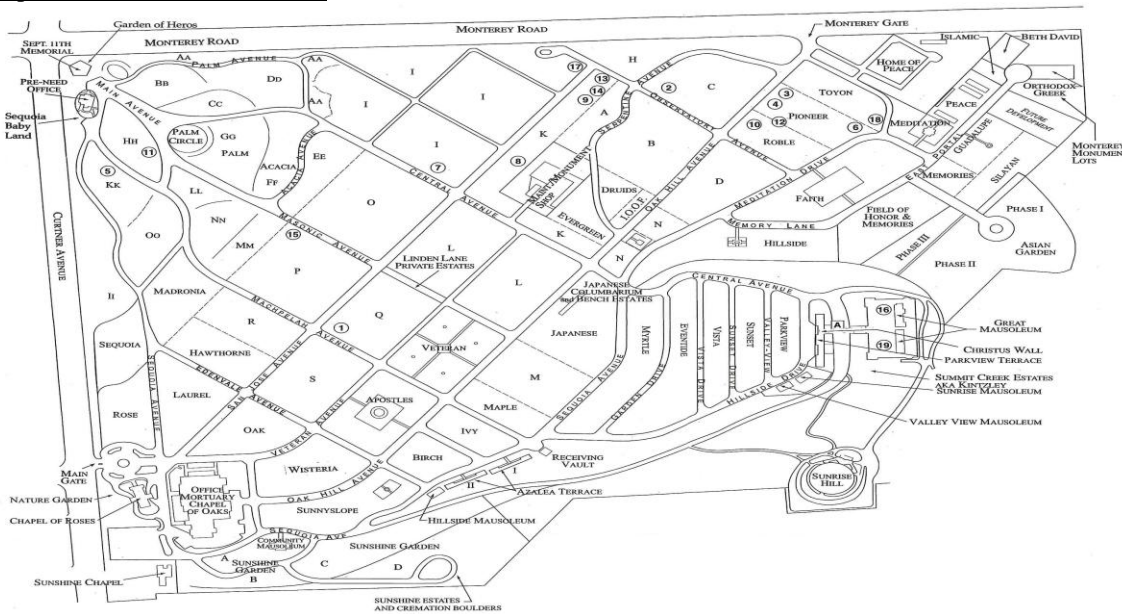

What to Bring

To make it easier for the Scouts to place the flags and avoid damaging the flag staffs, Scouts should have the following items:

- ✓ Large/Long Screwdriver
- ✓ Work Gloves

What to Wear

Scouts and Scout Leaders should be dressed in their BSA approved uniform

What to Expect

Check in outside Office Mortuary near the Main Gate – Check in begins at 9:30am

Flag Placement will not begin until 10am – Scouts arriving early will be asked to wait until start time

Scouts will work in groups to cover main veterans' sites as well as other sections of the cemetery

Boy Scouts will be asked to help document where veterans' graves are in older portions of the cemetery
